Regional Executive Views

When I was in high school, a classmate let me drive his Bugeye Sprite. I never got over it. In October 1963 I bought my first car, a new 1964 Austin-Healey Sprite Mk. II (Mk. I Bugeyes had suffered a modern restyling). However, they were upgraded to front disc brakes, and a 56 hp 1098 cc engine (up from 43 hp and 948cc).

I did acquire a 1959 Bugeye a couple of years later, and it immediately turned into a project. I suspect that 50 years may a bit long for a project of this type, so I am finally working on it again.

Through the years I was able to enjoy a number of LBCs (Little British Cars) – several MGBs, several MG Midgets, a Triumph TR-250, a Triumph Vitesse, a couple of Triumph TR-6s, a Riley Kestrel Saloon, a Jaguar XKE, a Morris Mini Minor, a Wolseley 1300, an MG 1100 Sports Sedan, an Austin-Healey 100-4, an Austin-Healey 3000, several more Sprites, a Lotus Elite, a Lotus Europa, a Sunbeam Alpine, and some non-British Alfa Romeos, Porsches, Corvettes, Volvos, and a Citroën. And of course a more recent acquisition, a Mazda Miata.

A number of these vehicles were not in my possession for long. I fancied myself as a part-time dealer. Great fun.

For many years I have wondered, do I drive the type of cars I do because I like to drive? Or do I like to drive because of the type of cars I drive? After years of soul searching and reflection, the answer is: I don't know.

I do know that after joining the Wichita Region SCCA in the late '60s, I knew I'd found a new home and family. I regret allowing my SCCA membership to lapse for a while, but I returned to the fold 20 years ago. It is nice to have family.

As my projects progress I'll try to keep you updated. First on the agenda is a 1963 MG Midget, red paint, red interior, red top. It'll become Connie's and my F Street Prepared autocross car.

Our 1987 BMW M6 is in the process getting a transmission replacement. Our 606,xxx-mile 1965 GMC pickup gets a new engine (a 405 cubic inch V-6), a new transmission (a 6-speed manual from a Ford F-350 Super Duty), and replacement body panels from a 1964 Chevy (augmented by a few new aftermarket reproduction panels). The 1959 Bugeye Sprite and a 1969 Sprite Mk. IV (essentially a replacement body for the recently euthanized Sprite RT) will follow.

MEETING MINUTES

(Subject to correction and approval at the next Salina Region board meeting)

August 3, 2014

Salina Region SCCA Aug. 3, 2014, meeting was called to order by R.E. Bill Preheim at 3:20 p.m. at Legends Bar and Grill, Salina. Board members present were Rocky Entriken, Artt Mann, Connie and Bill Preheim, Monte Rans, Dennis and Nancy Smith. Guest–Radlee Bien, Sandy Entriken, Raelynn Heilig, Charles, Srdjan and Janner Ortiz and Samantha and Haylee Terrill.

The June 29, 2014, minutes were presented and approved unanimously. Motion to approve by Dennis; seconded by Artt. The treasurer's report was presented and approved unanimously. Motion to approve by Rocky; seconded by Monte.

<u>Old Business</u> – <u>Ft. Riley-Discussion</u> held regarding the Ft. Riley MiDiv event. Also discussed were the number of minor waivers and parents complaints regarding completing multiple forms since the form only accommodates one child per form. Nancy will again attempt getting Risk Management to look into changing the form. She will also be addressing the problems we have encountered when ordering pylons through SCCA.

<u>ECRA Repairs</u> – Discussion was held regarding some new manmade holes in the concrete that if left unrepaired potentially could cause future damage. It was noted that we picked up more debris than normal, possibly left by a non-SCCA event the previous weekend. (Several bolts, glass and other metal pieces.)

<u>Bill Payment</u> – Discussion regarding online bill payment and how well it seems to be working out. Rocky presented Connie with the invoices he had paid online.

<u>Batteries</u> – Dennis reported that he purchased two new batteries for the timing lights and a charger which all arrived prior to the Ft. Riley MiDiv event.

<u>Event Chair Guide Sheet</u> – Discussion was held regarding a guide sheet for event chairs. Temporary adjournment from 3:40 p.m. to 3:46 p.m. to order food.

<u>New Business</u> – <u>Dylan Perney Memorial</u>: Rocky moved, Dennis seconded and it was approved unanimously to implement Salina Region's Memorials Policy and donate to the memorial fund in place at Sunflower Bank in Dylan's memory.

<u>Kart Safety</u> – Artt reported and discussion was held regarding SCCA possibly requiring kill switches on Junior karts in consideration of the tragic incident in Texas.

Shutdown Area Safety-Dennis reported that he is trying to make sure both timing cords are used to allow an adequate shutdown area for everyone's safety.

Octoberfast 10-5-14/Saturday Test-n-Tune 10-4-14 – Artt suggested we host a Test-n-Tune on the Saturday prior to Sunday's Octoberfast 25 event. He feels it would be great for Jr. Karts and novices to get seat time prior to a fast event. Discussion was held regarding getting the sanction in place, as well as securing the site and the need for a SSS. Artt moved, Connie seconded and it was approved unanimously. Artt will chair the Sat. Test-n-Tune. Dennis will contact SCCA to have sanction include Oct. 4. Rocky will contact the city regarding securing/scheduling the site for Saturday. Nancy confirmed the pricing would be the same as the March Test-n-Tune weekend, with the exception that our Octoberfast event is our free-to-members event.

Outside of the Lincoln events, this was the most successful Divisional in MiDiv in three years or so. 97 drivers. Note, the results above are the Salina Region Series version, the primary effect of which is to recognize the JBL class. Also, all the STO classes were non-points classes for the Divisional Series but do score points in the Salina Region series.

No surprise that FTD went to past FSAE National Champ Nick Roberts, driving KU's FSAE car in A Mod: 75.196.

Five classes were decided by less than one second, all but one of them less than half a second. Closest was K Mod, Artt Mann and Charles Ortiz traded wins each day but Artt was quickest overall by 0.169 sec. In STU Robert Pendergest shaded Mark Hill by 0.233. In STR it was Eric Brown just 0.252 ahead of Tim Heaton. STX was won by course designer Joe Silva by just 0.497 ahead of Charles Wilson. And in CSP John Hunter held off Matt McCabe by 0.528.

New member Radlee Bien stepped up at the last minute to take over the Aug. 3 event, originally scheduled to be chaired by Abner Perney. He drew a course containing four slalom runs, each a little different than the others, and all challenging.

A total of 29 drivers stepped up to the challenges, perhaps the tightest course we've run this year (wait'll we get to Octoberfast for the other end of the spectrum).

The fast-time battles produced the closest contests of the day. Zack Kimble in K-State's FSAE car took FTD at 45.178, while Srdjan Ortiz, the JA winner, was only 0.662 behind.

Even closer was Fast Fender, won by FSP winner Monte Rans in his Renault without even so much as a parade lap. He did it on his second run after DNFing his first. His gap was only 0.620 ahead of BSP winner Jesse Zimmerman, who warmed up with a couple of runs in his classic '65 Mustang before switching to his Saleen Mustang to finish out his day.

Fast Lady was Nancy Smith at 51.3.

Closest in-class duel was E Street again, Bill Preheim 1.833 over Rocky Entriken after Rocky coned his best run.

Biggest class was STO8, boosted by three Anderson family entries, won by Dennis Smith. Good to see several newbies!

SCCA Membership notes:

Normally your R.o.R. is the area in which you live, but it doesn't have to be. We have members who live in other Regions' territories, and some of those regions have members who live in our territory.

You may also join as many other regions as you like, paying their local dues for the purpose of winning local championship points, receiving newsletters and participating in their programs. These are "associate," "dual" or "secondary" memberships.

The final option is to simply pay local region dues, in which case you are merely a newsletter subscriber, and not eligible for Regional awards, Divisional points or to compete in major SCCA events.

Associate memberships are due now for the year 2014.
