

MEETING MINUTES

(Subject to correction and approval at the next Salina Region board meeting) The Oct. 20 meeting of the Salina Region SCCA was called to order by RE Monte Rans at 2:55 p.m. at the La Curva Restaurant. Board members attending were Theresa Walton, Artt Mann, Rocky Entriken, Dennis and Nancy Smith, and guest Lorna Mann.

Dennis moved the minutes from the last meeting be approved. Rocky seconded. Passed. Theresa presented the treasurer's report. Nancy moved to approve, Dennis seconded. Passed.

Old Business: The Dave & Jo Richards Award. Rocky proposed the following criteria: To be presented to an individual (or individuals) who has been a Salina Region member at least five years, who has taken a significant role in the Region's activities to the benefit of the Region and its Members, and who may also (but not necessarily) have been an outstanding competitor or worker/organizer on the Divisional and/or National level in any of the activities conducted by the Sports Car Club of America. This award is considered Salina Region's top honor, intended to be, but not required to be, presented annually.

Named for the longtime Salina Region founding members who, between them, served nine years as Regional Executive; both have been Driver of the Year, both have been Worker of the Year, both have been Divisional Solo Champions, both have competed in the Solo Nationals.

The award may be given to a recipient only once. A permanent traveling trophy will be held each year by the most recent recipient. Prior recipients will receive a "keeper" plaque the following year.

Rocky moved for the adoption of the award, Artt seconded. Passed.

As a separate item, Rocky moved that the selection committee would be the RE, Asst. RE and Past RE for the 2019 award; for 2020 the RE and Past RE plus the 2019 recipient; for 2021 the Past RE and the 2019 and 2020 recipients; thereafter the three most recent recipients, the most recent designated as committee chair. After discussion it was agreed that in the event of past recipient(s) unable to serve as a selector, that person would be replaced by the RE, Asst. RE and/or Past RE in that order. Seconded by Dennis. Approved.

Dennis moved that Rocky go to Mid-America Awards to price a suitable award and report back with options. Artt seconded, Passed.

New Business: Rocky moved that Salina Region apply to do a Divisional Championship event in 2020. Likely date June 5-6-7. Artt seconded. Passed.

Theresa moved to do a three-day Evolution Performance Driving School April 17-18-19, 2020. Monte seconded. Passed. A contract for the school has been signed and returned to Evolution.

Scheduling was discussed. Minimum participants was inquired with the reply that the minimum insurance charge is based on 20 participants (Sanction fee is based on actual number).

Monte reported on a request from Midwest Division for regional financial support of the Midwest Division Convention in February. We have already been providing two free entries to a local solo for the silent auction. Dennis moved, Nancy seconded, to continue that support and add a \$50 cash donation. Approved.

Artt moved to adjourn, Rocky second. Adjourned at 4:15 pm. Submitted, Nancy Smith, Registrar, as acting secretary.

OCTOBERFAST 30

It happened in 1990: George H.W. Bush was president, gasoline was \$1.34 a gallon, "Driving Miss Daisy" (car movie?) won the Oscar, the Berlin Wall fell, "The Simpsons" debuted on Fox, an IBM PS1 computer cost \$1000-\$2000, the World Wide Web was born. Also, Salina Region SCCA was born and Dave & Jo Richards were chair for the October event, which they called Octoberfast.

The original map survives, and has been used every year since for what has become the Member Appreciation Event. Salina Region members run for free, and this year 27 of them took advantage of the opportunity. We also had a number of newcomers that we hope to see again.

The course this year lived up to its name. Same map but perhaps a loose interpretation. Rev limiters were banging and 3rd gear was seen by many. Although a longish course, most times were in the mid- to upper-40s. We had 44 drivers total, largest entry this year other than our Divisional in June.

For old timers, it was good to see Mark and Jean Alft return after many years away from the sport. Weird to have them fill out Weekend Memberships. Cool to see Jean Alft on course followed by Laney Blume, each a 3-time national champion (Jean's first Nationals trophies were won on the ECRA concrete, then called Airport Park, in 1984-85). They didn't show much rust, Jean took Fast Lady with a 46.358 clocking, second in Super Stock in their Corvette. Laney's HS Civic was only 0.4 sec slower.

Closest duel of the day came from two non-member newcomers running in STO6. Andlee Phengphachanh (pronounced Peng-pa-con ... I think) in his firstever event did as told and started easy with a 68.5, determined where he left time and went quicker each run. Third run was 51.3, enough to eke a win over Keegen Mould from Overland Park by 0.223 sec. Andlee got down to 49s on his last two runs, but hit cones on both.

STO8 was also a close duel by non-members, eventually falling to Aaron Loggan's sunburst yellow Mercedes by 0.409 sec over Brandon Tapp's classic Corvette. The ES Ladies put on another show, Theresa Walton taking the all-Miata class by 0.494 over Sharon Brillhart.

E Street sent 10 cars to the course, going 4 deep in trophies. Brian Tefft Jr. still put a whuppin' on the rest of the class with a 43.130 run that also snatched Top PAX away from Russell Blume. FTD was a run by Larry Brady's FM Red Devil from Kansas City at 41.448, while Fast Fender went to Michael Hoyt from Nebraska in an XP Miata, only 0.125 sec slower at 41.573 sec.



# WINTER IS COMING

It seems appropriate for our November event, ending Salina Region's 2019 season, to finish out the Game of Thrones theme with the title from Season 1, Episode 1. Yet we may have had some of the best weather November will offer, a bright and sunny day that warmed into the 60s.

We had 24 drivers come to do the Endurokhana, each taking two 3-minute runs around Rocky Entriken's small and simple course offering laps in the 23-25 sec range. The primary object was to get in as many laps as possible. Most got in eight laps, but for many finding consistency was a challenge.

Only five drivers dipped into 22-sec lap times, but the one who did the single quickest lap (22.407) and also set FTD (8 laps in 3:06.248) was also the one who found a 22 only twice, once on each run – STO4 winner Tyler Naden.

The Teffts, Junior and Senior, each hit the 22s three times, but this was Tefft the Elder's day as he won the largest class, E Street by 1.323 sec over Mason Smith with Tefft the Younger taking third. It was the closest contest of the day from the largest class, seven drivers.

Michael Mace in STO4 ran four 22-sec laps, just 1.368 sec behind Naden – the second-closest class. Street Modified winner Scott Burcham turned nine 22s – but spoiled three with pylon penalties which also foiled his bid for FTD.

The consistency prize went to the three ES trophy winners and HS winner Brett Grier, the only drivers to make a run – and only once each – with all eight laps in 23 seconds. Grier used his consistency to run the best PAX time (with apologies to Brian Tefft Sr., announced at the event as top PAX).

Nancy Smith got Fast Lady, turning the 9th quickest run of the day among

the 19 drivers who got in eight laps.

We had a few drivers for whom the event was their first-ever autocross. One thing about doing multiple laps, they got a good idea of what Solo is about. We hope to see them again next season.
