

MEETING MINUTES

(Subject to correction and approval at the next Salina Region board meeting) RE Monte Rans called a special meeting of the Salina SCCA board members to discuss the Divisional Championship event June 6-7.

The Zoom conference call took place at 6:50 p.m. June 2, 2020. Participating were Tim Thompson, Hank Brillhart, Artt Mann, Aaron Loggan, Theresa Walton, Abner Perney, Rocky Entriken and Connie Preheim.

Tech inspection was discussed with Hank. He will have stickers to place on windshields for the starter to identify those cars which have completed tech. Annual tech from any region will be honored. There are forms to complete for those with, or requesting, an annual tech, also for the trailer file. Bill volunteered to help Hank tech on Friday.

Monte will ask Dennis for the safety information to put on the assignment sheet. Rocky has observed the grid numbers on the northeast side are faded but he felt the numbers could be identified by looking at the others before.

There are 87 entries so far, so three heats are anticipate depending on the adequate numbers of workers. Monte and Theresa are working on the arrangement of heats to ensure workers.

Monte is planning to be on site by noon on Friday to set up the course. Theresa and Tim volunteered to be there to help.

It was decided not to provide snacks and water due to the COVID-19 restrictions but a small number of water bottles will be in the trailer for emergencies since the temperature will be hot.

The number of entries necessitated three portable bathrooms which Rocky will arrange for.

Monte reported he had received an email message from Assistant R.E. Brett Greer that he will not be able to participate in autocross this season.

Rocky reported there were medical supplies (gloves, disinfectant, sanitizer) in the trailer.

MiDiv Solo Series #1&2

This was, we believe, the largest autocross Salina Region has ever pulled off. We had 97 drivers, nearly all hungry to get back on track after months of coronavirus delay. Twelve of MiDiv's 14 regions were represented. The only absentees were anyone from

Ozark Mountain (SW Missouri) and Mississippi Regions, and they were replaced by visitors from Texas and Lone Star Regions.

The only larger events we can remember on the ECRA concrete, other than six SCCA Solo Nationals 1975-85, were some Mirror Khanas back in the '80s when that event was the centerpiece of the Kansas Solo II Championship, which predated the MiDiv Solo Series as well as the formation of Salina Region in 1990. The largest Mirror Khana, then a Wichita Region event, pulled 129 cars.

Despite 100° heat, everyone was eager to get back to dodging cones. Monte Rans resurrected the course he intended for last year's Divisional, but which got shelved after the city used the east edge of our site for tree disposal after a wicked windstorm swept the city several days earlier.

Four runs on Saturday produced competition equal to the temperature, with eight classes decided by less than a second – two determining top honors for the day.

In F Modified, the only class to run sub-50 sec times, Brad Smith and Dan Wheeler shared the DoofWagon, a Formula 500 racer, to near-identical 3rd and 4th runs. Both turned 47.1s on their final runs, separated by 1/100 sec, but both also caught cones and had to sit on their third-run times, Wheeler's 47.560 only a licensed-to-kill 0.007 sec quicker than Smith's. And it was FTD, of course.

FFTD (Fast Fender) was almost as close, an STU matchup in which Mark Hill clipped Kevin Murphy by 0.245 sec. The two largest classes were equally close. ES, 7 cars, was a resumption of Team Tefft vs. Gang Green with Brian Tefft Jr. ahead of Joey Green by 0.046 sec. HS with 8 cars saw Texas visitor Cameron Goode outrunning Russell Blume by 0.436 sec. Other close matches came in CS, Luis Rodriguez 0.407 sec quicker than his car owner, Ethan Fudge; CP, Al Hermans over Chris Miller by 0.836 in a Mustang matchup; FSP, Bill Preheim 0.965 up on Abner Perney, and DSP, Dan Rowland 0.971 quicker than Jonathan Griffith. Mason Herrick, still required to have an adult passenger, took top PAX in an SSC Scion, just ahead of his dad, Mike.

Sunday saw a car through the dog park fence on first runs, requiring a slight course redesign and a do-over for the first heat. It became a 3-run day. The slightly quicker redesign enabled nine cars to beat 50 sec including all four F Mods. Wheeler claimed FTD again at 43.471 after Smith coned a quicker final run. FFTD again went to STU, but this time it was Murphy's when he ran 0.229 quicker than Mike Herrick's STS-winning time.

Other close contests included HS again, Goode over Blume by 0.394; AS where Frank Wietharn ran 0.814 quicker than James King; DSP with Griffith getting payback over Rowland by 0.982, and BS, Jim Harrison 0.989 quicker than Gus Jacob in a clash of Caymans. Top PAX went to GS winner Ron Williams.

\star Next Events: Sunflower Solo Showdown \star

The next three autocross events on the calendar are the Sunflower Solo Showdown, three events grown from the former R.E. Challenge between Wichita and Salina Regions. Now Kansas Region joins in, hosting the first event July 19 at Heartland Motorsports Park. After that, Yoder on Aug. 2 and Salina on Aug. 23.

All three events are Salina Region points events!

It's a friendly competition between the three regions. Each competitor scores points for their region based on class size and finishing position. So go to Topeka and Yoder to boost the Salina Region score!

Registration is open for all three Showdown events on MotorsportsReg.com. At Topeka you can also enjoy a Majors road race going on at the same time.

Directions to Topeka: From I-70 or Kansas Turnpike, exit to I-470, then Exit 5 to US-75, exit at 77th St./Gary Ormsby Drive, then straight east to Gate E to enter the track. You may have to sign a track waiver. After the tunnel turn left to the autocross pad. Check-in is at the event (not the registration building at the gate).





Daddy's Hunting Pylons

This time, the coronavirus played to Salina Region's benefit. Cancellation of one of the Divisional Solo events opened a date and we rushed to fill it, restoring one round lost earlier to the bug.

(In other good news, both cancelled Divisionals, Topeka and Neosho, have been rescheduled for October.)

This felt kinda like "back to normal," if you don't count the spacing and masking still necessary. No special permissions were needed, just the usual city permit already in hand. Dennis Smith drew up a fast course where 37 drivers were able to hunt cones. The hunt bagged 58 pylons, not counting the pointy victims of DNF runs.

It was Father's Day so a pair of father-son contests were highlights. New member Rick Nicholson and son Tim shared an MX5 in CS in their first-ever autocross, taking off big chunks of time each run with the son outrunning dad.

In STR it was James Davis and son A.J. in a pair of Miatae, the two running within fractions of a second of each other until dad uncorked a flyer on his final run for a $2\frac{1}{2}$ sec win.

Closest contest of the day was the FSP duel between Bill Preheim's MG Midget and Abner Perney's Mazda Protege, both cars the result of significant rebuilds. Bill led all day with Abner nipping at his heels, in the end just 0.570 sec behind.

It was a similar scenario in CAM \cdot C, with Dennis Smith holding off Jordan Cookus, a visitor from Nebraska. The Mustang vs. Camaro duel ended up with Dennis ahead by 0.680 sec.

A third close battle was the fight for FTD, both Mike Herrick and Mark Hill collecting pylons and DNFs in their hunt for fast times. Both in the same first heat, they were the only two to break 50 seconds. Mike's 48.574 to win STS, 0.708 ahead of Mark's STU-winning 49.282. The times also earned Mike Top PAX honors just ahead of son Mason, the Solo Spec Coupe winner.

Fast Lady went to Sharon Brillhart, posting times in E Street Ladies that eclipsed all three drivers in the Open class.
