### **MEETING MINUTES**

(Subject to correction and approval at the next Salina Region board meeting)

The board meeting of the Salina Region SCCA was called to order on December 13,
2022 at 7:10pm by RE Andlee Phengphachanh via Zoom. Also in attendance: Monte Rans,
Artt Mann, Hank & Sharon Brillhart, Dennis & Nancy Smith, Kale Morris, Abner Perney.

Minutes from the previous meeting – Were reviewed and unanimously approved.

Treasurers Report – Was reviewed and unanimously approved.

Old Business – Loaner helmets – are in. Dennis / Nancy to pick up and put in trailer. Timing equipment – "Extra" light and receiver may or may not work. Old battery is old. RS232/USB cable has been temperamental. Discussion around having spare timing light and receiver, battery, and new cord. Andlee has RC LiPo battery that we are going to attempt to use. Brian has two additional tripods. Dennis moved to buy additional timing lights and RS232/USB cable at total cost ~\$300. Hank seconded. Passed unanimously.

2023 MiDiv Divisional Solo – Historically Kansas region has held a MiDiv solo series event, and Wichita and Salina have alternated years. Wichita hosted in 2021 and 2022 and Salina provided a site for Kansas Region. Kansas Region's new site is too small for a divisional. Wichita and Salina have put in requests for 2023 divisional events. Waiting on Divisional Solo Coordinator Al Hermans to determine if Salina, Wichita or both will get a 2023 divisional.

2023 SCCA fees: May be a slight increase in fees for 2023. Waiting for confirmation. (SCCA confirmed fees on Dec. 16, a \$1.50 increase of total event fees –Ed.).

Trailer maintenance: Dennis will work on needed issues when he has time.

Mark Walker is officially a Salina Region life member for hosting our website.

New Business – 2023 season – Need to coordinate dates with surrounding regions. Historically have used the same basic dates as previous year adjusted to the nearest Sunday. Discussion around having more two-day events. Andlee will look into any potential conflicts. Dennis would like to run a Mirror Khana – Monte volunteered bracket spreadsheet that he has used in the past.

Commitments for 2023 board: Majority of existing board committed to another year. Dennis and Nancy would like to step down from registration and trailer wrangling, but will continue to help out during transition period. We are actively looking for new equipment manager and registrar. Andlee offered to take over online registration duties, and Nancy will continue onsite for the time being. Dennis offered to bring trailer on occasion. Trailer can continue to be stored at Abner's compound. Andlee talked to Rick Nicholson about being assistant RE.

Banquet status: Kale and Andlee have coordinated. Plan to have banquet at the Garage on February 11th from 11 to 3. \$12/person admission. \$13/plate for catering (no drinks). Board meeting prior at location provided by Abner.

**Open Forum** – Need to pay some taxes and penalties to Saline county for trailer (home location alternated between Ottawa and Saline county in 2022).

Next meeting Tuesday Jan. 10, 7 pm via Zoom. Andlee will send links ahead of time. Meeting adjourned at 8:12p.



## Evolution School signup is

Registration is open on MotorsportsReg.com for Salina Region's 2023 Evolution Performance Driving School. If you want to take your driving to the next level, this is the path.

The school is scheduled for April 14-15-16. If that seems a long way off, there were people who couldn't get in last year

because they waited too long. You can find registration links on www.evoschool.com or go direct to motorsportsteg.com.

The way it works is the school operates on a 6:1 ratio of student-to-instructor ratio. If 12 students sign up they'll send two of their championship-caliber instructors. If 18 or 24 sign up, they'll send three or four. But they need to know that earlier than later so they can make arrangements.

Here's Evo's description of the schools:

"Our Friday Phase One program is great for any skill level, from seasoned veterans to the complete novice. The Phase One features approximately 24 runs with our team of national caliber instructors. Each student will work with two different instructors throughout the day.

"Saturday's Phase Two program is great for anyone who has taken our Phase One, and is looking to take their driving to the next level. This program focuses on visualization, as well as mental preparation, and also features approximately 24 runs on four different course configurations.

"Sunday's Challenge School is intended for anyone who has taken our Phase One and Phase Two, and is looking to grab those last final tenths. Our Challenge program also

features approximately 24 runs on 3 different course configurations. The Challenge school will review the skills learned during the Phase

One and Phase Two, as well as use a technique that will help prove the importance of looking ahead. Challenge students will also be pitted against their instructors in the final session to help push the students to new levels.

"Single Day Pricing for each of the Evolution programs at this location is set at \$275. Those attending two schools will pay \$260 per school (total \$520), and those attending all three days will pay only \$250 (total \$750). "All Evolution Performance Driving Schools take place rain or shine, and students will use their own vehicle for training. Student's vehicles will under go a tech inspection the morning of, and all students should be sure to have plenty of fuel, oil, air, etc. for the day. Students are also required to wear a minimum of an M-2010 Rated Helmet. (Motorcycle Rated) If you do not have a helmet, loaners will be available.





National membership includes a "local" region of your choice. This becomes your Region of Record. Normally your RoR is the area in which you live, but it doesn't have to be. We have members who live in other Regions' territories, and some of those regions have members who live in our territory.

You may also join as many other regions as you like, paying their local dues for the purpose of winning local championship points and participating in their programs. These are "Associate" or "Dual Region" memberships. Salina Region's Associate Members are fully-vested members eligible for all our championships, voting rights, region offices and other member benefits. "Associate" membership only means region-of-record is elsewhere.

You <u>must</u> be a member to enter SCCA events. There are several different types of membership available, including Regular, Family, First Gear (under 25) and Military, plus short-term Trial (free) and Weekend (\$15) Memberships. Questions? #### • • • Associate memberships • • •

- Associate Memberships in Salina Region expire concurrent with National and Region-of-Record memberships. All Associate memberships paid direct to Salina Region are notified to SCCA Membership and expire on their National expiration date. Associate members are fully-vested members of Salina Region, although their Region-of-Record is elsewhere.
- Annual dues are \$15.00 both for single memberships and for family memberships (which includes spouse and children age 20 and younger).
- To become an Associate Member of Salina Region, contact SCCA Membership (call 1-800-770-2055) and ask to be included as a member in Salina Region. The Region's dues will be paid at that time and added to your renewal fees.
- Or, at renewal time, renew online and you will find an option to "Add Region." Scroll down to find Salina Region in the drop-down menu.
- If you choose to pay dues direct to Salina Region (for example, at an event), we will notify SCCA and your Salina Region membership will become part of your National membership renewal.
- Mailed subscriptions are available to non-members, \$15 for the calendar year.
