MEETING MINUTES

(Subject to correction and approval at the next Salina Region board meeting)
RE Andlee Phengphachanh called the meeting to order on October 17, 2024, at
7:16 pm via Zoom. Also present were board members Sharon Brillhart, Rocky
Entriken, Phelan Gagnon, Mason Libby, Aaron Loggan, Artt Mann, Abner Perney,
Dennis and Nancy Smith, and guest Geoff Leazer.

Artt moved to approve September meeting minutes, seconded by Mason. Passed. Treasurers report: Andlee put the bank statement from Bennington State Bank on the screen, detailing all debits and credits. After discussion of some items, Artt moved to accept the report, Phelan seconded. Passed.

Old Business – Trailer: A separate savings account has been opened to eventually fund a replacement trailer, seeded with a deposit from the club checking account and profit (after expenses) from Artt's barbecue at the Octoberfast autocross.

Debit cards: Mason (Asst. RE), Phelan (Solo Chair) and Justin Gagna (Equipment Manager) will receive new cards. The card held by Kale Morris (former Solo Chair) will be voided.

New Business – Computer: Discussion of computer issues at Octoberfast. Computer quit uploading times during second heat and they had to be hand-entered. Artt noted, "Ours (Axware) is a pirated version and the pirate isn't with us any more." Timing chief Aaron will research replacement systems and report back next meeting with a recommendation.

Banquet: Phelan to begin planning awards banquet. Dennis offered help. The committee to determine the 2025 Richards Award is Artt, Dennis & Nancy, and Monte Rans (past three recipients).

Past RE: Monte has not renewed his SCCA membership. Rocky moved to leave the post vacant, noting that three former Res are on the board. Passed.

Officers: Time to begin considering candidates for RE, Asst. RE and Secretary for 2025. Anyone who would like to run should contact Andlee.

Helmets: Nancy suggested not issuing loaner helmets until after driver meeting. We'll try this at November event. Rocky stated that new Snell Foundation standards will be issued in 2025, which annually begins misinformation about helmets expiring. The oldest (Snell 2010) helmets will NOT expire for solo use until the end of 2026 as helmets with the new Snell ratings will not be available until October 2025.

New member: Ethan Gibbs was welcomed as a new member as of before Octoberfast, per motion from Artt. SCCA, unbeknownst to Ethan, has installed him as a member of Kansas Region instead of Salina Region. Once informed, after the cutoff event, he corrected it immediately. The unanimous vote gets him a refund of his Octoberfast entry fee and restores his season points standings.

The process of setting up Octoberfast is to follow a course map drawn by Dave and Jo Richards 35 years ago. It never goes down quite the same way twice, but this year.... Well, the name of the event is October FAST! That finish was supposed to induce a wiggle and many cars did, but those who could straightline it needed <u>ALL</u> of the shutdown to get shut down!

So it makes sense that the top five times on the results page were the top five times of the event – James Harrison's 45.905 in a BS Toyota GR Supra just 0.389 sec ahead of Frank Wietharn's SS '24 Corvette Z51 (the newest car on the lot). Out of 46 drivers, they were two of just eight to break below 50 sec. Then there was one at 47 sec, Phelan Gagnon's AS 'Vette; and one at 48 sec, Mason Libby's BS Redline, before four drivers in the 49s led by John LaRandeau's BS GR Corolla, still only 3rd-best in class.

The closest class battle was in STR, one of two six-car classes, ES the other), Theresa and Mark Walton dueling in their red Miata. Theresa's 50.090 just 0.646 quicker than her husband. Illustrating how close it was, both did their best times on their fourth runs and their last tries were almost as good – Theresa went just 0.023 slower and Mark was 0.011 slower is all. Theresa also collected Fast Lady.

Steven Allen brought his M3 up from Wichita to give Andlee Phengphachanh some competition in STU. The two went at it fiercely – just one clean run out of their 10. That was Allen's third try and it wasn't even his best. He finally got a dirty 47.7 on his final shot after two DNFs. Andlee, meanwhile, left dead aliens in his wake on every run, nine total, and his best was a dirty 48.5, The final margin was just 0.805 sec.

In HS Dennis Smith tried just as hard to catch Don Herrick, but killed six cones in the effort. His one clean run was 52.0 on his third lap, but Herrick ran 51.2 on the same lap and that 0.833 margin was the difference,

Forty-six drivers included visitors not only from Wichita and Kansas City but also Nebraska and Oklahoma.

National membership includes a "local" region of your choice. This becomes your Region of Record. Normally your RoR is the area in which you live, but it doesn't have to be. We have members who live in other Regions' territories, and some of those regions have members who live in our territory.

You may also join as many other regions as you like, paying their local dues for the purpose of winning local championship points and participating in their programs. These are "Associate" or "Dual Region" memberships. Salina Region's Associate Members are fully-vested members eligible for all our championships, voting rights, region offices and other member benefits. "Associate" membership only means region-of-record is elsewhere.

You <u>must</u> be a member to enter SCCA events. There are several different types of membership available, including Regular, Family, First Gear (under 25) and Military, plus short-term Trial (free) and Weekend (\$15) Memberships. Questions? • • • Associate memberships • • •

- Associate Memberships in Salina Region expire concurrent with National and Region-of-Record memberships. Any Associate memberships paid direct to Salina Region are notified to SCCA Membership and expire on their National expiration date. Associate members are fully-vested members of Salina Region, although their Region-of-Record is elsewhere.
- Annual dues are \$15.00 both for single memberships and for family memberships (which includes spouse and children age 20 and younger).
- To become an Associate Member of Salina Region, contact SCCA Membership (call 1-800-770-2055) and ask to be included as a member in Salina Region. The Region's dues will be paid at that time and added to your renewal fees.
- Or, at renewal time, renew online and you will find an option to "Add Region." Scroll down to find Salina Region in the drop-down menu.
- If you choose to pay dues direct to Salina Region (for example, at an event), we will notify SCCA and your Salina Region membership will become part of your National membership renewal.
- Mailed subscriptions are available to non-members, \$15 for the calendar year.
